Your generosity powers signature programs like the **Gators and Waverunners Swim Teams** and the **Hitters Volleyball Program**, helping youth build skills, confidence, and sportsmanship in supportive, competitive environments. In 2025, **88 athletes** participated in Hitters tryouts as the program entered an exciting new chapter.

Donor support also fuels community-wide events such as the annual **Splash-N-Dash**, serving **54 participants**, expanded basketball and soccer clinics, and continued collaboration with **Lenawee Lacrosse**.

Because of you, the YMCA launched an **Active Older Adult program** in 2025, serving **90+ members** through fitness, education, and social connection—including shared trips with our Francis Family YMCA branch.
