531 children were served across five childcare locations. Through high-quality early learning programs, children gained the **social, emotional, and academic skills** needed for success, resulting in **91%** of our preschoolers entering kindergarten fully prepared to learn. Thanks to donor support, it is building strong foundations for lifelong success.

3754 youth participated in YMCA programs including sports, aquatics, swim team, art, dance, cooking, music, and Tae Kwon Do.
